



**Join us for the 2008
Bell Tower Festival Parade!
This year's theme is
"The Tower Of Power"**



The Bell Tower Festival parade is scheduled to be held on Saturday, June 14, 2008, starting at 11:00 a.m. The parade will start at the Jefferson-Scranton High School, located at Highway 4 and Ram Drive. This is on the south side of town. The entrance to the registration table will be from Highway 4, and there will be a sign at that corner.

When you enter the area, stop at the registration table and get your parade entry number. You will then proceed East on Ram Drive until another parade committee member directs you to your appointed placement in the parade lineup. Your cooperation during the lineup is very important and appreciated, as the parade runs much smoother when everyone follows the directions of the parade committee.

Enclosed is your entry form/insurance release. **Please be sure to sign the insurance release** at the bottom of the registration form. By taking the time to do this now, it will speed up your registration time on the day of the parade.

Entries the day of the parade will pay a \$20.00 late fee.

JUDGING:

You may choose to have your entry judged in one of three categories:

1. Commercial – business advertising/publicity
2. Non-commercial – class reunions, dance groups, floats, etc.
3. Thematic – entries that depict the theme of the Bell Tower Festival

Judging will take place in the line-up. *If you wish to have your entry judged you must be in place by 10:00 a.m. Saturday, June 14.*

GROUPS AND REUNIONS:

We request your vehicle and/or flatbed arrive at the high school **no later than 9:00 a.m.** to be properly placed in the parade. The Jefferson-Scranton Community Schools will be offering a shuttle bus service from the Community Center parking lot to the high school starting at 9:00 a.m. This will allow for less congestion at the high school prior to the parade. Please encourage your group members to use the shuttle. Group members should **not** drive to the high school because there is no parking available and cars without a number will not be allowed into the staging area.

POLICIES:

As in all public events, safety is of the utmost importance to festival and parade planners. The festival reserves the right to immediately remove **anyone** deemed as acting in an unsafe manner during the parade. This includes stunts, tricks, and the throwing of unsafe candy or trinkets into the crowd. No suckers may be thrown from the parade entries as the sticks pose a danger to eyes. Candy and other objects may be tossed into the crowd as long as care is taken not to use excessive force.

Horse entries will be placed throughout the parade **only if their own clean-up crew follows** them during the parade. Otherwise, horse entries will be placed at the end of the parade.

Please submit your completed registration form by Friday June 6, 2008, Lack of information could result in your entry being denied.
